The Pig On the Beach, Studland Bay, Dorset

Overlooking the sandy sweep of Studland Bay, The Pig on the Beach is the perfect base for a family romp along Dorset's World Heritage Coast. Child-friendly, these oh-so-chic rooms with wood panelled ceilings and four-poster beds will charm the barnacles off any grumpy toddler. Indulge in a spa treatment in the sheep hut, or go on a guided tour around the Pig's vast kitchen garden. Double rooms start at £139 a night.

BEST FOR ROLLING DOWN SAND DUNES

The Gallivant, Camber Sands, East Sussex

Tucked behind Camber's rolling, seagrass-spiked dunes is the Gallivant, a modern beachfront hotel with a cheery New England feel. The Big rooms open out onto a glorious five-mile sweep of unspoilt sands and come decked in muted seaside colours with driftwood furniture and wood-burning stoves. Potter around the antique shops of nearby Rye or race to the top of the Dungeness Lighthouse before kicking back on cosy, sheepskin-draped chairs for a crispy mussel club sandwich in the gourmet diner.

Double rooms start at £115 a night including breakfast.
